In pursuance of the sub-rule (3) of Rule 5 of the Noise Pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000, the Government of Goa is pleased to direct the "authority" specified in the Government Notification No. 7/4/98/STE/DIR/Part I/922 dated 04-12-2007, published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 37 dated 13-12-2007, Notification No. 7/4/98/STE/DIR/Part I/1545 dated 15-01-2010, Notification No. 7/4/98/STE/DIR/Part I/104 dated 23-04-2015 and Notification No. 7/4/98/STE/DIR/Part II/480 dated 12-09-2019, to permit the use of

loudspeakers or public address system during night hours (between 10.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight) during the year 2023, on the days specified in the Schedule hereto, throughout the State of Goa.

"Terms and conditions for issue of permission.

1. The permission shall be granted only on a case-to-case basis, in response to a specific application made by the concerned Village Panchayat Municipal Corporation/ Municipal Council or an individual in the State of Goa.
2. The provisions of the Noise Pollution (Regulation and Control) Rules, 2000 shall be strictly complied with.

3. The 'authority' concerned shall monitor the noise levels during the permitted festive occasion and other occasion also, and take prompt remedial action in the event of any violation of the same and of above conditions."

## Notification

No. 134-10-2015/ENVT&CC-DIR/1460

- Read: 1) Notification No. 118-10-2015/STE-DIR/819 dated 18-11-2019.  
2) Notification No. 118-10-2015/STE-DIR/65 dated 28-04-2021.

Whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India vide following notifications has notified an area around the boundaries of the Wildlife Sanctuaries/National Park/Bird Sanctuary in the State of Goa, as the Eco-sensitive Zone:-

- S.O. 221 (E) dated 23-1-2015 declaring an area with an extent of one kilometre of land or the water body, whichever is near to the Bhagwan Mahaveer Wildlife Sanctuary and National Park in the State of Goa, as the Eco-sensitive Zone.
- S.O. 615 (E) dated 25-1-2015 declaring an area with an extent of one kilometre of land or the water body, whichever is near to the Bondla Wildlife Sanctuary in the State of Goa, as the Eco-sensitive Zone.
- S.O. 555 (E) dated 17-2-2015 declaring an area with an extent of one kilometre of land or the water body, whichever is near to the Netravali Wildlife Sanctuary in the State of Goa, as the Eco-sensitive Zone.
- S.O. 607 (E) dated 24-2-2015 declaring an area up to the river bank abutting the Dr. Salim Ali Bird Sanctuary on the three sides of the said Sanctuary and to the extent of 100 mtrs. on the eastern side towards Chora village from the Sanctuary in the State of Goa as the Eco-sensitive Zone.
- S.O. 608 (E) dated 24-2-2015 declaring an area with an extent of one kilometre of land or the water body, whichever is near to the Cotigao Wildlife Sanctuary in the State of Goa, as the Eco-sensitive Zone.
- S.O. 616 (E) dated 25-2-2015 declaring an area with an extent of one kilometre of land or the water body, whichever is near to the Madhei Wildlife Sanctuary in the State of Goa, as the Eco-sensitive Zone.

And whereas, the Central Government in the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change has constituted a Committee called the State Level Eco-sensitive Zone Monitoring Committee for effective monitoring of all notified Eco-Sensitive Zone around the National Parks and Wildlife Sanctuaries in the State of Goa vide notification number S.O. 221 (E), dated 23rd January, 2015. The said Committee is also specified in the para 5 of all the aforementioned six notifications.
