
Enhancement in eUIMS (Electronic User ID Management System)

In terms of the provisions of the Rules, Bye-Laws and Business Rules of the Exchange and in continuation to Circular nos. MCX/TRD/494/2018 dated November 26, 2018 (User Management through eUIMS), MCX/TRD/100/2025 dated February 21, 2025 and MCX/TRD/304/2025 dated June 20, 2025, the Members of the Exchange are notified as under:

The Exchange has implemented additional features in 'eUIMS' – Electronic User ID Management System. These features will be applicable w.e.f., **March 30, 2026** in the below mentioned modules:

1. User Dashboard:

A centralized hub for tracking and managing user requests. Members can now create users manually or via bulk upload, download user list with updated details. Additionally, the dashboard categorizes records into following groups:

- a. Active User:** Provide information for all active user ids.
- b. Inactive User:** Provides information for all in-active user ids.
- c. Pending requests:** Provides information about all pending requests.
- d. History:** Provides information about all approved and rejected requests.

The User Dashboard in the updated eUIMS serves as a centralized hub where members can view comprehensive user details and initiate a wide range of requests, including modifications/ cancellation of users and update pro-location, custodial participant privileges and CTCL facility details. For any specific user id, the system allows for multiple request types, such as change of user name, change in terminal IP address, change of terminal address, change in certification details, etc.

2. New Facilities:

- a. Auto-Populating Terminal Address:** Based on drop down selected, terminal addresses will be auto populated for new users or change username requests.
- b. Document for Algo User type:** For existing approved Algo users, the system will no longer mandate document uploads unless member choose to update the same if there is change in the information/ details already uploaded.
- c. Proprietary Trading Disclosure:** When submitting a "Disclosure of Proprietary trading" request, members can now upload up to three attachments through eUIMS.
- d. Proprietary Trading facility – Multi Location:** Members can now register up to five different locations in a single application or via bulk upload when requesting for "Pro Trading facility - Multi Location.

- e. **Default Location for Proprietary Trading:** Members can now set default location for proprietary trading or update an existing one directly through the eUIMS portal.

Members are requested to take note of the above.
